It's hard to believe the summer is over! This by far has been the busiest summer Club 180 Ministry has seen in its eleven years. During the month of June our focus was our older youth, 9th - 12th graders. We offered a Disciple Now Weekend, an Arts Camp, Sports Camp and a camp entitled "Acceptance". Thank you to Smithwood Baptist Church, Clairmont Hills Baptist Church, Fellowship Bible Church, and Pathway Church for giving yourselves away to our youth and community. The month of June ended with 10 of our youth, along with Chris Johnson and Nissa Burkeen, getting the opportunity to join a Youth Camp in Panama City, Florida through scholarships given to us by Indian Lake Peninsula Church. What a blessing for them to experience a church camp on the beach and learn more about evangelism. They were forever changed!

Our Summer Day Camp just ended this past Thursday, which caters to 1st - 8th grades. What an amazing four weeks kids had as each week focused on a different theme and was hosted by a different church. Our themes this year were: "Freedom in Christ," "Emoji World," "The Avengers (Full Armor of God)," and "Your True Colors." Thank you Tabernacle Church, Villa Ricca Baptist Church, Gateway Community Christian, and Southside Baptist Church. How exciting to see these Mission Teams bring who they are in Christ and love and serve our kids. The University of Alabama Nursing Program also came and hosted a Medical Clinic for our Community. This has become a partnership that will benefit the people of this area. What a blessing all who have come and served with us have been to Club 180 and our community.

Now to the BIG NEWS! Club 180 Ministry is moving to a new location as we have the opportunity to take over and manage a much larger facility. After much prayer, we feel this is the right move. God is putting all of the pieces of the puzzle together and we trust His leading as we have since the beginning of this Ministry. There are probably a lot of questions, and we are anxious to share all of the details on how and why we are doing this and what this means for the future of Club 180 Ministry. God has faithfully provided for us according to His word in so many ways. The Scripture that has steered and shaped Club 180 is Isaiah 61, with the focus being verses 1-3. However, after 11 years, and now working on our 3rd move, God has revealed another verse of that Scripture that depicts for us a part of the journey we haven't recognized until now. Verse 4 says; "they will rebuild the ancient ruins. They will restore the places destroyed long ago. They will renew the ruined cities, the places destroyed generations ago." God is being faithful to finish what He started and raising up a generation that will change the face of this community forever. In the new facility, we have a gym that we are already utilizing for a basketball ministry and Karate. A huge cafeteria that will serve the community with meals during the winter and for other events throughout the year. Our After School Program will have better space and Esther's Closet will be conveniently located to serve young mom's. This will also allow us to house Mission Teams up to 100 people at a time. As for our current location, God has made it possible for Willing Hearts Ministry to purchase the building and use it to further ministry in our community by providing classes in stain glass, fusing glass, and ceramics. Local people that fall into the category of low income, no income or disabled qualify for the program. When they make an item, it goes for sale in the Studio and 80% of that sale goes into a benevolence fund earmarked for that student. As the student needs bills paid, groceries, gas or other necessities, Willing Hearts can pay for those needs from that account. We are so excited to see what God does to further Club 180 Ministry as well as Willing Hearts Ministry. Please pray for both ministries as we begin to make this move in August and September.
