Happy New Year from Eastern Kentucky! Club 180 Ministry is gearing up for this new year and anticipating what God will do in 2017! We already have lots going on and our year is getting filled up quickly with those coming to serve alongside us. God is so faithful and through His guidance Club 180 will do all it can do to reach the lost in our Community and beyond. Here are some things already in place and some things on the horizon:

- Friday Night Fellowship - Club 180 Ministry, along with other Ministries, Churches and individuals come together to prepare and serve a hot meal to anyone in our Community. Our facility is the perfect place to host this event. The first Friday was challenged with snow and extremely cold weather, however we served 25 people. We expect to double that number in the weeks to come. This ministry will continue every Friday through the end of February. The Winter months take a toll on families as they struggle to pay high electric bills and still be able to feed their family.
- River's Edge Fellowship - This is the church plant within Club 180 that started over two years ago. This past Fall our church hosted several neighborhood Block Parties to help introduce ourselves to the Community and invite the unchurched to join us for worship. River's Edge is a small church, but we are a disciple growing church. In January we began reading through the Bible as a church and we are excited to see what God does through this adventure together.
- Cross Trainers Youth Group - We have about 15-20 youth that meet for Bible Study on Sunday evenings. They will be going to Winter Jam in February and are already preparing for a Mission Trip to Dewy Rose Baptist Church, Georgia in the Spring where they will be leading Backyard Bible Clubs and helping with other projects. Please pray as they prepare spiritually and financially.
- Girl Power - Now that Christmas break is over, Angie and Maddie will start meeting with Middle School girls every other week. Girl Power is a program that empowers young ladies to become Godly leaders among their peers. Building self esteem and pouring into them through God's Word is the key to this ministry.
- Friday Fun Nights - This is a new event that will begin in March. Every Friday night we will host a fun night where we celebrate silly and interesting things. Some nights already planned are: National Kazoo Day, Popcorn Day, International Story Telling Day, Strawberry Ice Cream Day, Trivia Day, and so many more. This will be a night to engage youth, have fun and most importantly share Christ. We are hoping area churches will partner with us and bring their youth as well.
